# Clemson Fall Classic Horse Show Safety Rules

---

*The Clemson Fall Classic Horse Show strives to have a safe and fun event for all participants. By following these rules, will help us ensure a safe environment and keep the show operational.*

- Masks or face coverings must be worn properly (covering nose and mouth) at all times in the show arena and on the competition grounds.
- All individuals must always practice social distancing while on the competition grounds by staying at least 6 feet from any person who is not a member of their immediate household.
  - Members of the same household are always still required to wear masks or face coverings while on competition grounds and in the show arena.
- Anyone on the competition grounds must complete a waiver form and agree to have your temperature screened at check-in and randomly throughout the show.
- A green armband is required for admittance into the arena and must always be worn on the competition grounds.
- Anyone entering the competition grounds are required to self-monitor their temperature at least once daily prior to entering the competition grounds.
  - Anyone with a temperature of 100.4° F or higher may not enter the show grounds and must notify show management.
- The following individuals are not allowed to enter the competition grounds:
  - Anyone who exhibits COVID-19 symptoms,
  - Anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within last 14 days,
  - Anyone who has tested positive outside of the past 14 days, but is still symptomatic, or
  - Anyone who has been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 14 days.
- No “general public” spectators will be allowed on the competition grounds.
- Minors who do not have a valid driver’s license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind. This includes but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the show/competition grounds.

***Failure to comply with safety rules will result in you being asked to leave the facility and possibly removed from the show grounds. Thank you for participating in the show and for helping us keep the show operational by following these rules.***
